

Sustainable action in the Maritim Hotel Frankfurt



The Maritim Hotel Frankfurt has agreed to participate in the GCB's www.fairpflichtet.de initiative and is taking proactive steps to adhere to their guidelines. Known as the Sustainability Codex, the guidelines regulate corporate responsibility as it pertains to economic, ecological and social aspects of the event industry.

The measures our hotel is taking with regards to sustainability are listed below:

Energy, water, refuse

- Implementation of energy-saving LED lighting.
- BREEAM (BRE Environmental Assessment Method) certification with the evaluation excellent and good.
- Requirement-based implementation of movement sensors and switch timer programs as it pertains to the exterior illumination and sections of the interior lighting.
- Ongoing, centralised energy controlling.
- Use of an air conditioning and ventilation system with waste heat recovery.
- Reduced flush option on the toilets and water flow reducers in all showers and sinks.
- Energy efficient minibar retrofitting.
- Annual refuse audit through the Fraunhofer Institute's internationally recognised sustainability certificate in accordance with DIN EN ISO 14040.
- Use of biodegradable cleaning agents.

Food & Beverage

- Predominate usage of seasonal and regional produce.
- Observance and implementation of optimal logistics as they pertain to raw material acquisition.
- Economical, energy efficient and requirement-based policies for food and beverage preparation.
- Expansion of vegetarian dining choices.
- Usage of reusable beverage packaging.

Guests and employees

- Formation of a pro-environment work group with externally trained sustainability consultants heading up projects.
- Internal and external employee training in the areas of waste disposal and technology.
- Co-operation with the national railway (DB) for environmentally conscious travel to and from events.
- Ticket/Regiocard offers for guests.
- Bicycle provision for guests.
